

ESB, Ireland's largest renewable energy generator, and Parkwind, a leading Belgian wind energy company, will host a series of consultation events on the proposed Clogherhead Offshore Wind.

A virtual public consultation on the proposed project will launch on Monday 6th March. The consultation will be open for a period of 6 weeks, closing on Sunday 16th April. It will provide upto-date information on the project as well as offer an opportunity for interested parties to provide feedback and get informed of project progress.

A webinar will then held from 7:30–8:30pm on Tuesday 14th March which will provide up-to-date information from the Clogherhead Offshore Wind project team as well as offer an opportunity to the public to submit questions or provide feedback.
